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INTER ISLAND LONG DISTANCE SERVICES

I. APPLICATION

This tariff contains the definitions, regulations and rates applicable to Inter Island Long Distance Message Telephone Service furnished by the Verizon Micronesia, hereinafter referred to as the Telephone Company.

II. DEFINITIONS

In addition to the General Definitions set forth in this tariff Section 1, the following definitions will apply. Inter island long distance telephone service is the furnishing of facilities for telephone communication between telephones in different local service areas (inter island) in accordance with the regulations and rates as set forth in this tariff.

A. Collect Call

A call which, upon request, is reversed billed to the called station, provided the charges are accepted by the called station.

B. Initial Period and Additional Minute(s)

The "initial period" is the minimum interval of chargeable time allowed a connection between given parties.

Additional minute(s) is the unit of time used in excess of the initial period.

C. Main Billed Account

The account associated with a customer's service to which MTS charges are billed. Such an account may include one or more local exchange telephone number(s).

D. MTS

Inter-Island Message Telephone Service.

E. Mechanized Calling Card Service

Provides customers with the option of billing Dial Station-to-Station calls to Telephone Company-authorized calling cards. The person originating the call dials zero, the telephone number desired, and the Telephone Company-authorized calling card number.

F. Person-to-Person Service

Person-to-Person service permits the call originator to specify the person he wants to talk with or a station, department or office to be reached before timing of the call begins. When a Person-to-Person service connection is established and the specified called party is not available, the call originator may request or agree to speak to the answering party. However, the call will remain classified as a Person-to-Person call. Advance arrangements to reach a particular person or station for the establishment of a connection at a specified time (appointment call) are classified as Person-to-Person calls. (Z)

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G. Station-to-Station Service

Station-to-Station service provides for the call originator to dial the telephone number desired or give the Telephone Company operator the telephone number desired, or give the Telephone Company operator only the name and address under which the desired number is listed without specifying a particular person or station to be reached.

Classes of Station-to-Station calling are:

Dial Station-to-Station Service

This is a service where customers may dial direct from other than a public or convenience pay telephone without the assistance of a Telephone Company operator, except when it is necessary to: record the originating telephone number; place a call for a handicapped person who is unable to dial the call; and to re-establish a call which was interrupted. This service includes Mechanized Calling Card calls.

Operator Station-to-Station Service

This is a service where the Telephone Company operator assistance is required to place calls for collect (reverse billing), calling card or third number billing; to process calls made from a public or convenience pay telephone or hotel guest room telephones; to give time and charges and time notifications.

H. Two-Point Service

Two-point service is that of furnishing facilities for telephone communication between two telephones, two private branch exchange systems, two stations of private branch exchange systems or CentraNet® systems or combinations thereof.

III. REGULATIONS

In addition to the General Regulations set forth in this tariff, the following regulations will apply. (Z)

A. General

1. Limited Conversation

The Telephone Company reserves the right to limit the length of conversation when a shortage of facilities exist in times of emergency.

2. Obligation of the Customer

a) The calling party (or customer) shall establish his identity in the course of any communication as often as may be necessary.

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b) The calling party (or customer) shall be solely responsible for establishing the identity of the person or person with whom connection is made at the called telephone.

3. Service Used for Data Transmission

Inter island long Distance Message Telephone Service may be used with data transmitting and receiving equipment (including teletypewriter and telewriter equipment) for the transmission and reception of data. Regulations applicable to data transmission are contained in this tariff. (Z)

4. Use of Service

Message Telephone Service is provided for use by the customer and may be used by others, when so authorized by the customer.

B. Two-Point Service

1. Classes of Service

These are Dial Station-to-Station, Operator Station-to-Station, and Person-to-Person. Charges for messages within these classes of service are based upon the time and day of the week when the connection is established.

2. Timing of Messages

a) On Dial Station-to-Station and Operator Station-to-Station calls, chargeable time begins when connection is established between the calling station and the called station.

b) On Person-to-Person calls, chargeable time begins when connection is established between the calling person and the particular person or station specified or an agreed alternate.

c) Chargeable time ends when the connection is terminated at either point.

d) Chargeable time does not include time lost because of faults or defects in the service.

e) The Telephone Company will attempt to furnish time notifications, as requested, but does not guarantee the performance of this function.

f) When a message begins in one rate period and ends in another, the rate in effect during each rate period applies to the portion of the message occurring within that rate period.

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3. Reversal of Charges (Collect Calls)

Charges for all classes of telephone calls may, upon request, be reversed; that is, charged against the called telephone, provided the charges are accepted at the called telephone.

4. Mechanized Calling Card Service (MCCS)

Mechanized Calling Card service applies to those MTS calling card calls where the customer dials the telephone number desired and the call is completed without the assistance of a Telephone Company operator and the call is billed to a calling card.

MCCS calls may be placed from Dual Tone Multi-Frequency (DTMF) equipped telephone instruments only, including DTMF equipped public and semi-public telephone stations. Multi-party lines are not eligible to place MCCS calls.

Mechanized Calling Card MTS calls will be charged based on the Dial Station-to-Station rates set forth in IV. Rates following.

5. Initial Period, Additional Minutes and Discounts

Rates are quoted in terms of initial periods and additional minutes.

a) Initial period rates are for connections of one minute or any fraction thereof.

b) Additional minute rates are for each additional minute or any fraction thereof that the connection continues beyond the initial period.

c) Discounts for Evening and Night and Weekend rate periods are expressed as a percent reduction of the charges calculated at the Day rates.

(1) The discount is applied to the sum of the initial period and additional minute charges as determined from the rate tables in IV. Following.

(2) When application of the discount results in a fractional charge, the amount will be rounded down to the lower cent.

6. Public Payphone Usage Surcharge

In addition to any Operator Handled Service Charge, this fee applies to all completed Local and Intra LATA long distance calls that are made from a payphone and are not paid in coins. This surcharge does not apply to calls made to emergency numbers (911) or calls made by hearing or disabled persons to a telecommunications relay service (TRS).
